

ICAC Talk for final year Investment Science students

On 26 October 2011, afternoon 4:00p.m, we had invited the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC) to deliver a talk to our final year Investment Science students. The talk was hosted by Ms. Rika Chan, Community Relations Officer from ICAC Community Relations Department of Kowloon West District. During the 1-hour talk, Ms. Chan introduced Hong Kong anti-corruption legislation, common corruption pitfalls at workplace and the importance of work ethics to our students who are expected to enter employment market next summer. In addition, Ms. Chan had also brought us an interesting video clip and some real-life corruption cases in banking sector. She also briefly introduced to our students about ICAC recruitment program and career development.

The talk increased our students' awareness in personal ethics, and equipped them with the knowledge of anti-corruption and prevention. They had an interactive and enjoyable time.
