 They should include the title, author's name and affiliation, 3-5 keywords, and main references. The abstract should not exceed one A4 page.
- 2. Abstracts will be anonymously reviewed. Please prepare two copies, one with author's name and one without, and submit them through the online system (platform link TBC).
- 3. Each individual can submit a maximum of one individually authored abstract and one co-authored abstract, with a total of no more than two submissions.

15 February 2024 (Thu): Abstract submission deadline (Online submission platform TCB)

27 March 2024 (Wed): Notification of abstract acceptance.

10 April 2024 (Wed): Online registration deadline.

16 April 2024 (Tue): Official invitation letters will be issued.

* Upon the completion of the conference, presenters will be invited to submit their full papers. The conference proceedings will be published by the Hong Kong Polytechnic University Press after review. Further details will be announced in due course.

Presentation Details

Sessions:

Parallel sessions for scholars and teachers, as well as postgraduate student forums, will be held. Each presentation is limited to 20 minutes, followed by a Q&A session.
