

Outstanding PolyU Alumni Award 2007: *Call for nominations*

The Outstanding PolyU Alumni Award 2007 is open for nomination from now to 12 January 2007. Launched in 1996, this biennial selection jointly organized by PolyU and the Federation of PolyU Alumni Associations (FHKPUAA) gives public recognition to outstanding graduates of the Institution for their professional accomplishments and contributions to the community.

All graduates of PolyU, PolyU staff, Honorary Graduates, Council members, Court members, University Fellows and members of Departmental Advisory Committees are welcome to nominate any bona fide graduate for the selection.

The seven-member Panel of Judges for the Award is chaired by the HKSAR's Secretary for Economic Development and

Labour Mr Stephen Ip Shu-kwan.
