Participants of the Natural Dyeing Class will be able to make a pocket square with the onion skin dyeing method and upcycle their old clothing with the process of Japanese indigo dyeing. Participants of the Colour Dyeing Class will learn to make a tote bag and an apron using the double colour dyeing method and triple colour dyeing method respectively.

Ms Siu Tsz-ching and Mr Josh Chang are tie dye artists from Hong Kong and Taiwan. They travelled to Yunnan to learn tie dyeing from the Bai ethnic group and later embarked on a fruitful career in this traditional art. They have been invited to exhibit in Hong Kong and Taiwan, and have also organized workshops in Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan to promote the art of tie dye.

本地紮染技藝師蕭芷澄小姐與臺灣紮染技藝師張智晞先生,曾遠赴雲南向當地少數民族白族學習傳統紮染技術,及後二人開始從事紮染創作,並於港、澳、臺三地開辦課程。兩位先後獲邀參與香港兆基創意書院舉辦的「另一個圈」展覽、臺北藝術空間 SUNSET 的「ENDLESS SUMMER」展覽、並於 2017 年舉辦全港最大型紮染展「逆光」,宣揚紮染藝術。
