

# UrbanFarming@Y6 - Phase 10

## Background

An urban farming programme has taken root in The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) as the Campus Sustainability Committee and Campus Sustainability Office jointly launch the "UrbanFarming@Y6" programme on Hung Hom main campus to encourage sustainable living. The programme offers many benefits to participants who want to experience and learn organic farming practices. It demonstrates the possibilities of growing food crops on campus and enhances social interaction.

## Details:

- Farm location: 6/F, Block Y
- Period: **02/03/2019 – 07/06/2019**
- Quota: 20 people by drawing lots
- Fee: Free of Charge
- Language: **English** supplemented by Cantonese terms when appropriate
- Deposit: HK\$ 400 will be collected per person. Please ready the deposit by preparing a crossed cheque in Hong Kong dollars made payable to "The Hong Kong Polytechnic University". Please write your name, Student/Staff ID no. and contact telephone number at the back of the cheque, and submit this deposit in person to the Campus Sustainability Office (address: Room Z502, 5/F, Block Z, PolyU) within office hours on designated dates.
- Subject to **fulfillment of 4 workshops attendance requirement (including the compulsory session)**, and in compliance with all guidelines/Terms and Conditions, the deposit will be refunded to the participants. Participants will be notified in due course and they should collect such refund in person at the Campus Sustainability Office (address: Room Z502, 5/F, Block Z, PolyU) within office hours on designated dates. The organizers reserve the rights to confiscate the deposit.

- \*This is a compulsory session in which all participants will work together with the organizer in revitalizing planter boxes, soil and compost mixing, etc.
- Seeds will be provided by tutor.
- Workshop will be postponed if Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 or above is hoisted, or when Red or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force two hours before the workshop commences. It will be re-scheduled to another date subject to further arrangement and announcement made by the Organizer.
- Planter box (approximate size: 0.9m x 0.6m), seeds and compost will be provided to participants.
- All current PolyU staff and students are welcome to enroll.

### Terms and Conditions:

#### Application and enrollment

- Application and enrolment is open and interested parties should complete the online application form.
- Application or request to enroll into the programme made after the stated deadline will not be entertained.

#### Attendance

- Participants should commit to attend all workshop activities of the programme.
- Participants should write in email and inform the organizer in advance of any upcoming absence from the workshop activities. They should write to [green.campus@polyu.edu.hk](mailto:green.campus@polyu.edu.hk) and provide a reason.
- Absence without prior notification and/or without reason will be recorded and be taken into account to determine if the participant can fulfill the minimum 4 workshops attendance requirement.
- Only when participants fulfill the attendance requirement, i.e., 4 workshops attendance requirement (including the compulsory session) and are able to meet all Terms and Conditions, they can collect the refund of deposit.

#### Access to Block Y

- PolyU staff members can access 6/F, Block Y and visit the farm from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during Mondays to Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.
- PolyU students can access 6/F, Block Y and visit the farm from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during Mondays to Saturdays. If they wish to access Block Y during Sundays and Public Holidays, prior written application should first reach the organizer in which names, Student ID numbers, contact telephone numbers should be provided.
- Identification documents such as Staff Card and Student Cards may be required to produce as a proof of identity upon request of campus security officers.

#### Activity at the farm

- Planters are allocated by the organizer and participants are not allowed to change, to exchange with others or share with non-participants.
- The organizer reserves the right to disqualify any group whose planter boxes are left unattended for over 2 weeks.
- Please be cautious when applying tools for planting, and please clean up and return all tools to the storage cabinet after use.



- Only natural fertilizers such as Bone Meal are to be applied.
- Chemical fertilizers, pesticide and exotic plants are not allowed on the farm.
- The organizer reserves the right to trim, prune or remove the plants if the plants extend out from the planter boxes
- Damage to any facilities is not allowed.
- Open burning, burning candles and incense are not allowed.
- Please respect other participants and ensure all access is free from obstruction.
- Please take care of your belongings and planters as the organizer will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- Please clear all plants and personal belongings by the end of planting period.
- The organizer reserves the right to disqualify anyone who, in its opinion, has tampered with or disrupted the operation or violated the rules.
- The organizer reserves the rights to exercise final decision.
- Please follow our updates on website or Facebook and to check if there is any official announcement in relation to the programme.
- For emergency, please contact Campus Security Control Centre at 2766 7666.

#### Adverse weather arrangement affecting the farm

- The farm will be closed if Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or when Red or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force. The farm will re-open in two hours if the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 is lowered at noon or before. Otherwise, it will be closed. The organizer will not be responsible for any damage to the planters due to bad weather. Please notify the organizer if any facilities are damaged.

- 不得破壞或擅自修改農莊內的設施或設計。
- 不可在農莊生火。
- 請尊重其他場地使用者及請保持通道暢通。
- 主辦單位將不會對農莊內任何農作品或物品失竊承擔任何負責。
- 在種植期完結之前，必須清理種植箱上所有植物及個人物品。
- 如有任何參加者違反以上規則，主辦單位可隨時終止該參加者的參加資格。
- 主辦單位擁有一切事項之最終判決權。
