### Duties

The appointees will assist the project leader in the research project - “World Health Organisation (WHO) Collaborating Centre for community health services”. They will be required to:

- (a) assist in the implementation of the project;
- (b) develop and conduct pilot testing on the minimum standards to promote psychosocial aspects of adolescent health;
- (c) improve health outcome by developing and testing effective psychosocial service delivery model/program via community-based interventions for people across the life span in Asian countries;
- (d) contribute and influence WHO member states’ policies and programmes in the matters related to health service provision through policy, research programmes and education related to WHO Collaborating Centre’s activities;
- (e) develop research proposals and assist in the application for external funding;
- (f) coordinate and implement activities related to the project and provide logistics support;
- (g) carry out systematic reviews;
- (h) draft progress reports for the project;
- (i) assist in conducting literature search and literature review;
- (j) assist in subject recruitment and data collection for the project;
- (k) assist in data analysis, drafting of reports and presentation of materials; and
