### Duties

The appointee will assist the project leader in the research project - “Self-administered acupuncture for insomnia disorder: a randomized controlled trial”. He/She will be required to:

- (a) conduct interviews with patients;
- (b) assist in general coordination/management;
- (c) assist in subject recruitment and various aspects of data collection;
- (d) liaise with participants and staff to facilitate study progression and management; and
- (e) perform any other duties as assigned by the project leader or his delegates.

### Qualifications

Applicants for the **Research Associate** post should have a master’s degree in Nursing, Chinese Medicine, Psychology, Medical Sciences or related disciplines in Healthcare or a good honours degree in one of the said disciplines with at least three years of research/relevant work experience.

Applicants for the **Research Assistant** post should have an honours degree in one of the above disciplines or an equivalent qualification.

Applicants should also have:

- (a) some experience in conducting research with an asset in clinical settings;
- (b) good computer literacy including MS Excel and Chinese word processing;
- (c) a good command of both written and spoken English; and
- (d) good interpersonal and communication skills.
