Duties

The appointees will assist the project leader in all aspects related to the relevant research projects of language learning and processing using neuroimaging and other advanced technologies (e.g., virtual reality). They will be required to:

- (a) conduct literature review, data analysis, programming, maintenance of equipment and recruitment of study participants;
- (b) engage in writing and publishing scientific papers based on the projects; and
- (c) perform any other duties as assigned by the project leader or his/her delegates.

Qualifications

Applicants should have:

- (a) an honours degree/a master degree from a recognised university in language sciences or equivalent qualifications with less than four years of post-baccalaureate qualification experience at the time of appointment; and
- (b) a documented track record in training and evidence of strong background or experience in neurolinguistics/psycholinguistics or related areas.
