Duties

The appointees will be required to:

- (a) provide leadership in all aspects of the School's academic activities, including academic leadership, teaching, research and consultancy;
- (b) teach at undergraduate and postgraduate levels and supervise student projects and theses;
- (c) conduct research that leads to publications in refereed journals and award of research grants;
- (d) engage in applied research, creative development and consultancy projects in relation to healthcare related activities;
- (e) contribute to academic and departmental administration; and
- (f) render professional service to the community and support activities that promote or foster links with the profession in the industry and/or in the community.

Qualifications

Applicants should have:

- (a) a PhD degree in Nursing or a relevant discipline;
- (b) a substantial record and reputation as an accomplished teacher with significant contribution to curriculum development/review or teaching and learning processes;

- (c) an established track record in research and scholarship, including refereed publications, external grants and postgraduate supervision; and
- (d) demonstrated academic management and leadership capabilities.

Candidates with lesser experience will be considered for appointment at the level of Associate Professor. The job duty requirements and expectation would be in line with the appointed grade.

Remuneration and Conditions of Service

Salary offered will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Applicants should state their current and expected salary in the application. Initial appointments will be made on a fixed-term gratuity-bearing contract. Re-engagement thereafter is subject to mutual agreement. Remuneration package will be highly competitive.
