

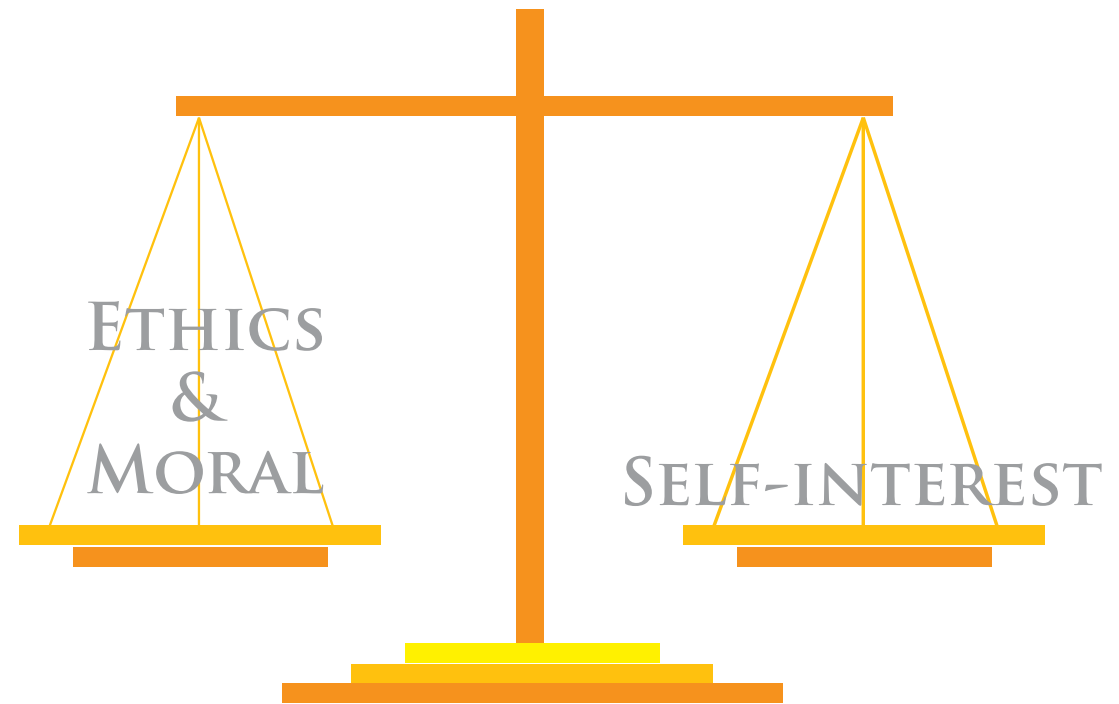
ETHICS AND MORAL EDUCATION PROGRAMME

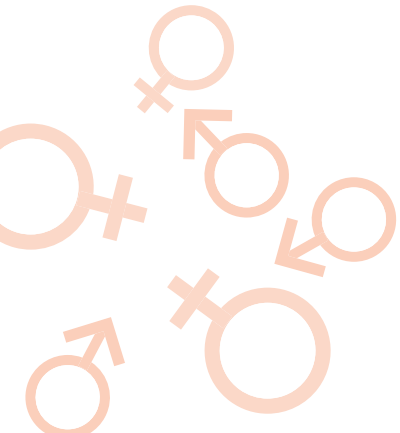


ACTIVITY I

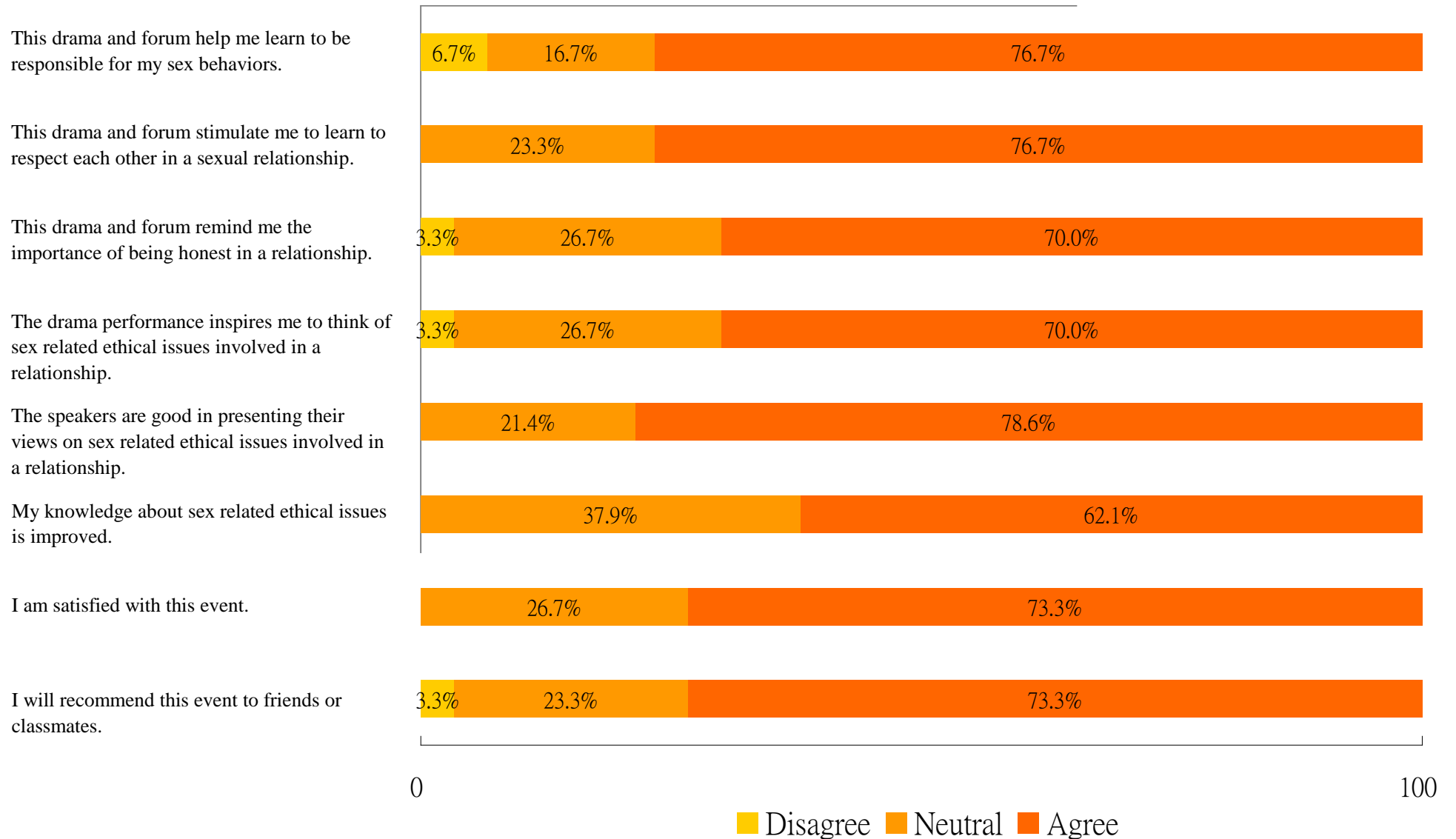
Let's talk about SEX:

ACTIVITY II

To be or not to be:

Exploring Your Ethical Values through Real Life Situations Case Presentation Competition

The Ethics and Moral Case Presentation Competition is a major activity of this Programme to encourage students to explore their ethical values through cases discussion and reflection. Students from various departments are encouraged to join the competition in teams. The activity attracted 23 teams (53 students) from various departments joining the competition. The case presentation competition has been held on 17 February 2009 (Tuesday) from 12:30-2:30pm on Suen Chi Sang Memorial Square. An award presentation ceremony also held immediately after the competition. The panel judges have given their valuable feedback & professional input on students' performance.
