CAREER PREPARATION PROGRAMME (CPP)

CPP aims to help students who are about to enter the graduate job-hunt process through advanced and industry-specific training on job hunt skills. Full-time undergraduates are eligible to join and priority is given to students who are in their final-year of study and have taken related CPS basic training.

THE CAREERS GROUP

The Careers Group is a student-run group supported and advised by SAO's Career Development Services Section. It aims to engage students in the planning and organising of career-related activities that ultimately bring total benefits to all PolyU students and graduates. Participation in the Group's activities offers a platform of experiential learning that can be fun and dynamic.

'PREFERRED GRADUATE' DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (PGDP)

Offshore internship opportunities are offered to students to widen their horizons and for fulfillment of WIE requirements. Students are encouraged to take the opportunity to develop strong adaptability, cultural awareness, interpersonal and communication skills and many other workplace competencies. Full-time undergraduate students of UGC-funded programmes are eligible to join.

RECRUITMENT TALKS AND ACTIVITIES

The Career Development Services Section makes their best effort to bring potential employers to the campus so that students can have direct access to good job opportunities in the market. Students are encouraged to make good use of the opportunities to interact with prospective employers and learn more about their requirements and expectations.

WORK-INTEGRATED EDUCATION (WIE) INTERNSHIP TRAINING

Different types of training and workshops are being offered to cater for the various needs of students:

- get prepared for the first experience of a real work environment
- know how to build your career portfolio with internship learning to impress future employers.

Full-time undergraduate students are eligible to join.

WORK-INTEGRATED EDUCATION (WIE) TRANSCRIPT

Students who have completely fulfilled the WIE required by their academic programmes and have been granted the graduate status are eligible to a WIE Transcript, which lists the details of your WIE activities and serves as a testimonial for your work-based learning.
