Description should be written in English or bilingual.

Exhibition

1. 10 - 15 photos would be selected for exhibition.
2. Date of exhibition: 2 weeks from mid March to mid April 2010.
3. Venue to be confirmed.

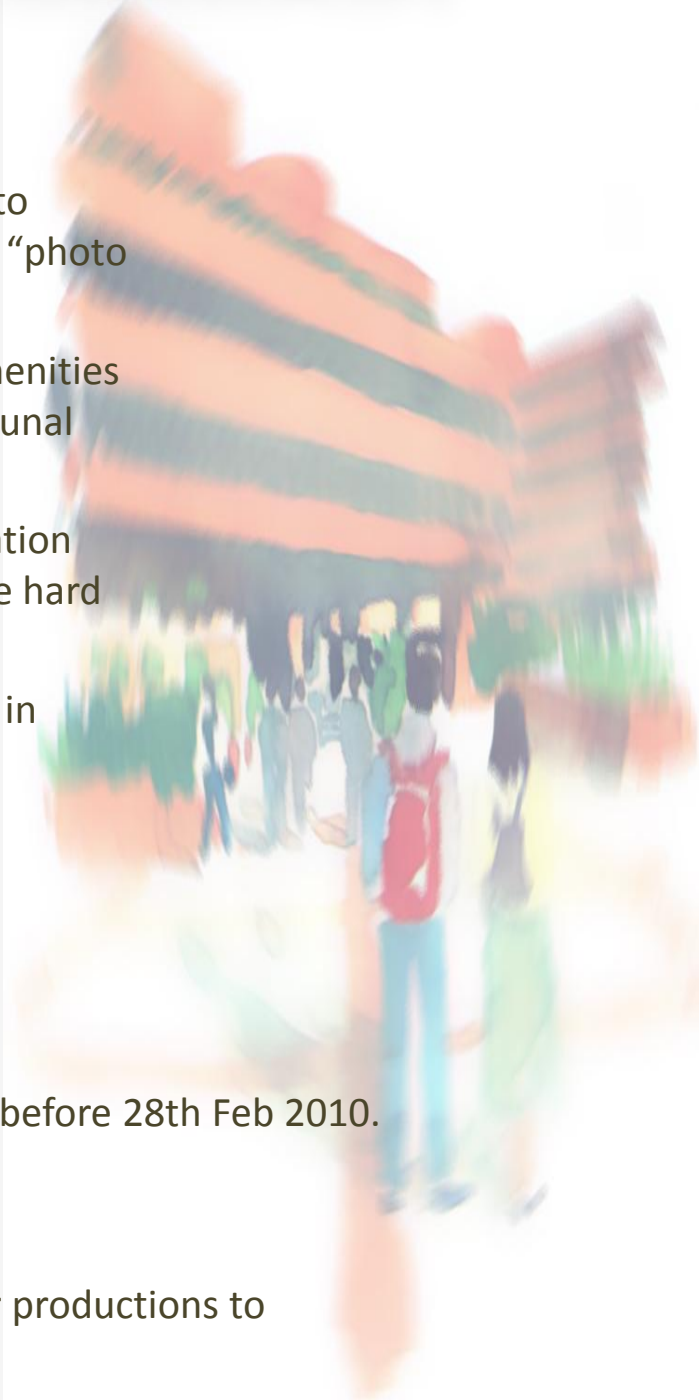
- a. Full name in English to be shown in exhibition
