### Abstract

Developed countries face an ageing population and increasing chronic disease, imposing strains on health care systems which tend to rely on acute, episodic care. Integrating care across providers and health care sectors has been proposed with, at its heart, the concept of care centred around the needs of service users. However, this longstanding, simple idea raises many challenges, some of which will be described along with attempts to deal with them, drawing on examples from Europe and USA.
