Insights from Eye Movements: Diagnostic Insights (and the Occasional Mystery) from an Eye Movement Lab

Abstract

This seminar will review a series of cases where eye movement recording has provided valuable diagnostic information in patients with nystagmus or other ocular motor abnormalities. It will also include some cases where the final diagnosis has remained to be made. The importance of not viewing recordings in isolation but in considering them in the context of other clinical information and a good history will be stressed. Most examples will be drawn from ophthalmology and optometry but a few from fields as disparate as psychiatry and geriatrics will also be included. Discussion will be appreciated and encouraged.
