2. A PLEAD to participate in the staff forum on 18/19 - 23/24 Strategic Plan

The University is drafting the Strategic Plan for the coming five years. PUSA strongly recommends that staff members of all ranks to try to attend the open forum organized by the Senior Management that will be held on 5th June regarding the first draft. Our Vice Chairman, Ming-yin CHAN has been appointed into the Strategic Task Force to represent staff views, but still it is *vital that every one of you* voice out how you hope the University should develop in the next five years. The deadline for registration for this event is 31st May and the link is given directly below. As it is arranged at 1100, PUSA would like to plead the seniors of Departments/Units to allow staff members, especially those non-academic staff members who have fixed office hours, in one way or another, to attend the open forum so that they may try their best to listen to the ideas of the Task Force and share their views.

3. Major areas of Work Concern over the Period

In several formal and informal dialogues with the Senior Management over the past few months, PUSA has been stressing the importance of a few issues for the betterment of staff benefit. These issues are, namely, the extension of retirement age, a more transparent and fair staff appraisal system, and a better job prospect for the teaching track staff. The response from the Senior Management has been most unfavorable to the first issue. PUSA believes the three issues will have long term impact on the work prospects and job stability of staff members. We will continue to pursue these issues and we hope all staff members may back us up on these requests.

4. Appeals on Humanitarian Ground

Over the years, when there were major calamities such as earthquakes, flooding or tsunamis, PUSA would appeal to staff and students of the University to help victims by their donations. This time, we would like to appeal to you for helping a little girl who desparately needs bone marrow transplant to save her life.

Baby Sophie is 18 months old. She was hospitalized for 3 months earlier this year in Queen Mary Hospital as she fought pneumonia which caused respiratory failure. The

poor girl was born with a genetic disorder resulting in her having a deficient immune system. The only treatment is a bone marrow transplant.

5. A Change of membership of PUSA as endorsed in the AGM

In the reconvened AGM held in December 2016, it was voted by members present to quit from the Hong Kong Higher Education Staff Associations (FHKHESA) and join into The Confederation of Tertiary Institutes Staff Unions (CTISU). The decision was based on the hope of striving for more long-term benefits and favorable terms of reference within our work environment, and to obtain more commodity and sales discounts from different sources. The process is near completion and is under the supervision of Registry for Trade Unions of the Labor Department of HKSAR Government. All staff will be informed after the completion of the process.
