New PUSA Officers elected

The Re-convened Annual General Meeting of the Association was held on Wednesday 8th December. The Annual Reports and the Financial & Auditor Reports presented by the Chairman and the Treasurer respectively were approved. Furthermore, John Sager and Derek Liu, both from EDC, were elected Vice-Chairman and Assistant Secretary of PUSA respectively during the meeting, for a term ending November/December 2022.

New developments in Merit-based Salary Adjustment (MBSA)

In PUSA Alert No. 24, we briefly reported our discussion with Central Management on the issue of MBSA for 2020-2021 fiscal year. Through prolonged and persistent negotiations with Central Management and Council during the past few weeks, PUSA Officers representing all staff members in Council were able to convince the University to maintain the existing MBSA mechanism and resulted in a percentage of salary increase ranges from 0.5-3.5%. Such an adjustment is assigned to concerned staff members according to their performance instead of job type (academic or non-academic), as some other universities have adopted. Overall, the percentage increase is not uncompetitive with reference to the macro economy of Hong Kong.
