Welcome to the Master of / Postgraduate Diploma in Professional Accounting (MPA/PgDPA) programme at the Faculty of Business of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU).

Launched in 1998/99, the MPA/PgDPA programme is the first postgraduate accounting conversion programme in Hong Kong accredited by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. It also received the recognition of various professional bodies, including ACCA, CPA Australia, the Taxation Institute of Hong Kong and The Hong Kong Chartered Governance Institute, facilitating our graduates to earn professional qualifications that match their career goals.

The programme offers a flexible study mode which allows students to study part-time or full-time. There are two exit points (postgraduate diploma or master's degree) to meet different needs of students. Applicants with valid professional qualifications may be admitted with advanced standing and granted exemption of half of the required credits. Therefore, students can work with and learn from classmates from diverse backgrounds, further enriching their learning experience.

The MPA/PgDPA curriculum covers the latest developments in the areas of accounting and technology. The seven core subjects in the programme (forming the postgraduate diploma curriculum) develop core competencies in accounting and finance which are vital for a professional accountant's success. We also offer compulsory and elective subjects over a wide spectrum of areas, including corporate governance, business analytics, mergers and acquisitions, and accounting and taxation in Mainland China. Our courses are delivered by qualified faculty from diverse backgrounds. With substantial practical experience in the profession and active engagement in scholarly research, they offer professional expertise and application of research findings to the classroom.

We are also committed to help students in their professional development through career development workshops and guest lectures, which provide opportunities for students to network with the industry professionals and gain insights into the latest developments in the ever-evolving business landscape.

Aim

This programme helps students to become professional users, preparers and auditors of accounting information upon completion of the Postgraduate Diploma (PgDPA), and expert users of accounting information for making executive decisions upon completion of the Master's degree (MPA).

Features

- Accredited / recognised by various professional bodies
- Graduates are eligible for exemption from up to 10 Modules in HKICPA's new Qualification Programme.
- Graduates may gain exemption from 9 papers of ACCA professional examination.
- Graduates meeting other undergraduate prerequisites can become associate member of CPA Australia.
- Graduates are eligible to apply for exemption of 3 papers under the Chartered Governance Qualifying Programme of The Hong Kong Chartered Governance Institute (HKCGI) and exemption of 2 papers under the Chartered Tax Adviser Qualifying Programme of The Taxation Institute of Hong Kong (TIHK).
- Applicants who possess professional designations (i.e. HKICPA, ACCA or CPA Australia membership) with substantial professional experience or Master of Corporate Governance (MCG) from PolyU will be granted a transfer of a maximum of 18 credits, enabling them to complete the MPA award within **ONE** year on a part-time basis.

Structure

- Students must complete 7 Core Subjects (21 credits) for the PgDPA award.
- Students must complete 7 Core Subjects, 2 Compulsory Subjects and 3 Elective Subjects (36 credits) for the MPA award.
- Classes are normally scheduled on weekday daytime / evenings and / or Saturday afternoons.

Core Subjects for MPA and PgDPA (21 credits)

- Accounting for Corporations *
- Accounting for Strategic Management *
- Auditing Framework *
- Financial Reporting Environment *
- Hong Kong Tax Framework *
- Management Accounting *
- Managerial Finance *

Compulsory Subjects for MPA (6 credits)

- Accounting Theory *
- Corporate Governance *

Elective Subjects for MPA[^] (any three) (9 credits)

- Business Analytics in Accounting and Finance
- Finance for Multinational Corporations *
- Financial Statement Analysis *
- Mergers and Acquisitions *
- Strategic Tax Management in Hong Kong and China
- Theory and Practice of Accounting in China *

[^] Not all subjects will be offered each year and it is subject to staffing resources and student enrolment.



* These subjects have been included in the list of reimbursable courses under the Continuing Education Fund. The mother programmes (Postgraduate Diploma in Professional Accounting / Master of Professional Accounting) are recognized under the Qualifications Framework (QF Level[6]).

Mode of study: Mixed-mode

Students can pursue their studies in either a full-time stream (MAF/PAF) or part-time stream (MAE/PAP). In general, **one daytime/evening class** per week will be scheduled for each subject over a regular 13-week semester and **two daytime/evening classes** per week over a 7-week Summer Term.

Duration

MPA

Students should normally be able to complete the programme full-time in 1 year and part-time in 2 years.

PgDPA

Students should normally be able to complete the programme full-time in 1 year and part-time in 1.5 years.

Entrance Requirements

- A Bachelor's degree in business[#] awarded by a recognized tertiary institution; or
- A non-business Bachelor's degree awarded by a recognized tertiary institution plus evidence of completion of fundamental business course(s) deemed acceptable by the School of Accounting and Finance of PolyU.

If you are not a native speaker of English, and your Bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification is awarded by institutions where the medium of instruction is not English, you are expected to fulfil the University's minimum English language requirement for admission purpose. Please refer to the "Admission Requirements" section of Study@PolyU for details.

Suitable candidates may be invited to attend admission interviews.

[#] Applicants who have completed courses in Financial Accounting, Economics, Business Law, Statistics, Management and Marketing are deemed to be business degree holders.

Fee

The tuition fee is HK\$318,600 per programme for MPA (36 credits) and HK\$185,850 per programme for PgDPA (21 credits).


