Mr Chan is currently Chairman of China, Regional Managing Partner of Greater China, and Member of The Global Executive of Ernst & Young. With over three decades of experience in the accounting profession, he has made paramount contributions to advancing financial services consulting, assurance services and the adoption of FinTech in the industry. A strong believer in realising business transformation with technologies and innovations, Mr Chan was among the early advocates of green finance and to spearhead its development on the mainland. He has been appointed advisor for the “Research and Promotion on SDGs Impact Financing in China” project by the United Nations Development Programme China and China International Center for Economic and Technical Exchanges under the Ministry of Commerce. Mr Chan has been actively involved in global and national economic and sustainable development initiatives, including the Belt and Road Initiative, the Greater Bay Area Development Plan and Green Finance Development. He serves as the Vice Chair of the Chinese Financial Association of Hong Kong, a member of the Hong Kong Securities and Investment Institute and the Hong Kong Academy of Finance. Chairman of Shenzhen Ebeca Beauty Technology Investment Co., Ltd., Ms Chan has been a remarkable player in the health and beauty industry of mainland China. As early as 1983, she introduced the French brand Ebeca to the local market and successfully acquired the brand in 1992. Since then, she started building her empire with a vertically integrated supply chain, encompassing more than 60 spa salons across the country, a biotech company for own product development, beauty schools, stem cell anti-aging treatment centres, organic farms and an investment company focussing on health and beauty-related opportunities. Over the years, Ms Chen has been devoted to boosting and standardising service quality within beauty industry, serving as the Vice President of Shenzhen Beauty Industry Association among other offices, earning countless accolades such as Women with Outstanding Entrepreneurial Spirit in China, and made it into China Top 100 Outstanding Women Entrepreneurs, and Shenzhen Top 10 Outstanding Women Entrepreneurs. Since 2016, she has been serving as the Chairman of PolyU Pearl River Delta Alumni Network, strengthening the bonding between her alma mater and Chinese enterprises.

Mr Tino Kwan Wing-kuen

Mr Kwan is one of the most celebrated masters in the world of lighting design, and has been a pioneer in green lighting and the energy conservation movement since early 1980s. His unique vision in creating spaces with light and shadow and his keen eye for exquisite details have earned him countless honours, including the Lifetime Achievement Award from Hong Kong Interior Design Association, and he was listed in the Hall of Fame by Interior Design Magazine China. His avant-garde works are found all over the world, ranging from luxurious hotels, casinos, Michelin Starred Restaurants, to luxury homes. Being a lecturer in local design institutes and the Tsinghua University in Beijing, Mr Kwan is also passionate about passing on his knowledge and philosophy to younger designers. He is also one of the mentors of PolyU's "Inspire" mentorship programme and served as the lighting consultant of Hotel ICON. He is currently the President of Asia-Pacific Hotel Design Association and the Vice Chairperson of The Asian



Association of Lighting Designers, contributing to the advancement of the lighting industry.

Ir Dr Leung, Asia Pacific Chief Executive Officer of DHL Global Forwarding (Hong Kong) Limited, overseeing its operation in over 20 territories, strongly believes in the company's motto – connecting people and improving lives. He has been pushing the envelope to embrace new technologies within the organisation, especially in leading the digitalisation process and coping flexibly with the unprecedented challenges posed by COVID-19. Caring for the prospect of the industry and welfare of fellow workers, Dr Leung has been serving as the Honorary Chairman of Hong Kong Logistics Management Staff Association. In 1997, he went to Shanghai and helped establish the first hypermarket "Lotus", which is now a megastore chain with more than 100 branches across the country. Leading the CP Commercial and Real Estate business, he initiated the upgrade project of the Super Brand Mall in 2016 and established a standardised management system. Under his leadership,



new innovative retail models were launched, and the Super Brand Mall was honored with various accolades. Mr Ross is not only a seasoned business leader, but also a humanitarian who cares about the community, supporting education, healthcare and disaster relief initiatives in China. In recognition of his vital contribution to Shanghai's economic and social development, the Shanghai Municipal People's Government bestowed Silver and Gold Magnolia Awards upon Mr Ross in 2017 and 2020 respectively.
