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<b>Objectives</b>	<p>This subject covers a selected range of major construct and theories in cognitive psychology to help students understand some common cognitive processes. It is aimed at enabling students to gain more advanced experience of some of cognitive psychologists' studied issues through their own experimentation and analyses. The subject provides students with opportunity and supervision to engage in learning activities that can stimulate them to appreciate research findings on learning and methods of thinking. The class will also allow independent planning and execution of experiments. Finally, implications for clinical and educational contexts will be examined.</p>
