The Pros and Cons of Undertaking Offshore Placement

+A

Pros

- Shorter time frame
- Eye-widening exposure
- 120% concentration (Put aside work, focus on placement)
- Personal growth and introspection

Cons

- Financial stress
- Schedule too packed
- Difficult for casework (limited time, hard for building rapport)
