

## Class Cancellations During Bad Weather

For Classes that HAVE NOT YET STARTED	
<b>Signal No. 8 or Above Is Hoisted</b> <i>(as announced by the Hong Kong Observatory)</i>  <b>Signal No. 8 or Above Will Be Issued Within Two Hours</b> <i>(as announced by the Hong Kong Observatory)</i>  <b>'Extreme Conditions' Are In Force</b> <i>(as announced by the Government)</i>	Class Arrangements
• From <b>6.30 am</b> but before <b>12.00 noon</b>	All classes commencing <b>before 2.00 pm</b> will be cancelled.
• At or after <b>12.00 noon</b> but before <b>4.30 pm</b>	All classes commencing <b>from 12.00 noon and before 6.30 pm</b> will be cancelled.
• At or after <b>4.30 pm</b>	All classes commencing <b>from 4.30 pm onward</b> will be cancelled.

### Examples of Class Cancellations

Scenario		Announcement Time *	Two Hours Before Hoisting	Signal No. 8 or Above Hoisted	Affected Classes
1	<b>Announcement Over 2 Hours Before Hoisting</b>	11.00 am	4.00 pm <i>(reference time)</i>	6.00 pm	All classes commencing <b>from 12.00 noon and before 6.30 pm</b> will be cancelled. <i>(Reference time: two hours before hoisting time, 4.00 pm, NOT announcement time.)</i>
2	<b>Announcement Exactly 2 Hours Before Hoisting</b>	4.00 pm	4.00 pm <i>(reference time)</i>	6.00 pm	All classes commencing <b>from 12.00 noon and before 6.30 pm</b> will be cancelled. <i>(Reference time: two hours before hoisting time, 4.00 pm)</i>
3	<b>No Prior Announcement (Immediate Hoisting)</b>	—	—	4.30 pm <i>(reference time)</i>	All classes commencing <b>from 4.30 pm onward</b> will be cancelled. <i>(Reference time: actual hoisting time, 4.30 pm.)</i>

\* The announcement time has no impact on class arrangements. Only the **reference time (two hours before hoisting or actual hoisting time)** determines class cancellations.
