

Class Cancellations During Bad Weather

Signal No. 8 or Above Will Be Issued Within Two Hours (as announced by the Hong Kong Observatory)				
'Extreme Conditions' Are In Force (as announced by the Government)				
• From 6.30 am but before 12.00 noon	All classes commencing before 2.00 pm will be cancelled.			
• At or after 12.00 noon but before 4.30 pm	All classes commencing from 12.00 noon and before 6.30 pm will be cancelled.			
• At or after 4.30 pm	All classes commencing from 4.30 pm onward will be cancelled.			

Examples of Class Cancellations

Scenario		Announcement Time *	Two Hours Before Hoisting	Signal No. 8 or Above Hoisted	Affected Classes
1	Announcement Over 2 Hours Before Hoisting	11.00 am	4.00 pm (reference time)	6.00 pm	All classes commencing from 12.00 noon and before 6.30 pm will be cancelled. (Reference time: two hours before hoisting time, 4.00 pm, NOT announcement time.)
2	Announcement Exactly 2 Hours Before Hoisting	4.00 pm	4.00 pm (reference time)	6.00 pm	All classes commencing from 12.00 noon and before 6.30 pm will be cancelled. (Reference time: two hours before hoisting time, 4.00 pm)
3	No Prior Announcement (Immediate Hoisting)	_	ı	4.30 pm (reference time)	All classes commencing from 4.30 pm onward will be cancelled. (Reference time: actual hoisting time, 4.30 pm.)

^{*} The announcement time has no impact on class arrangements. Only the **reference time (two hours before hoisting or actual hoisting time)** determines class cancellations.
