

## **Class Resumptions After Bad Weather**

For Classes that HAVE NOT YET STARTED				
Signal No. 8 Is Lowered (as announced by the Hong Kong Observatory)  'Extreme Conditions' Are Cancelled (as announced by the Government)	Class Arrangements			
• At or before <b>6.30 am</b>	All classes will be held as scheduled.			
After 6.30 am but at or before 12.00 noon	All classes commencing from 2.00 pm onward will be held as scheduled.			
After 12.00 noon but at or before 4.30 pm	All classes commencing <b>from 6.30 pm onward</b> will be held as scheduled.			
• After <b>4.30 pm</b>	All classes commencing <b>from 6.30 pm onward</b> will be cancelled.			

## **Examples of Class Resumptions**

	Scenario	Announcement Time #	Signal No. 8 Is Lowered	Affected Classes
1	Announcement Over 2 Hours Before Lowering	2.00 am	6.30 am (reference time)	All classes will be held as scheduled. (Reference time: actual lowering time, 6.30 am, NOT announcement time.)
2	Announcement Exactly 2 Hours Before Lowering	4.40 am	6.40 am (reference time)	All classes commencing from 2.00 pm onward will be held as scheduled. (Reference time: actual lowering time, 6.40 am, NOT announcement time.)
3	No Prior Announcement (Immediate Lowering)	_	4.30 pm (reference time)	All classes commencing from 6.30 pm onward will be held as scheduled. (Reference time: actual lowering time, 4.30 pm.)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>#</sup>The announcement time has no impact on class arrangements. Only the **reference time (actual lowering time)** determines class resumptions.
