

# <u>PolyU Step-By-Step Guide on Online Application Submission for Special Talents Admission and Recognition Scheme</u>



Please sign up an account via <u>eAdmission</u> and fill in your personal details, programme choice, qualification and other required information for admission application. If you have outstanding achievements in Sports, Arts and Culture, Leadership and Community Services or STEM and wish to be apply for Special Talents Admission and Recognition Scheme (STARS), you are also required to complete:

- A. "Other Experiences and Achievements" Section AND
- B. "Special Talents Admission and Recognition Scheme (STARS)" Section


#### Points to Note:

- 1. 2026/27 STARS application period is <u>from 16 September 2025 to 5 February 2026</u>. Late submission will not be entertained.
- 2. Any missing information will be considered as a failure in STARS application.
- 3. STARS application has to be submitted along with the PolyU online application form. Any addition and/or amendment request will not be allowed after application submission.
- 4. JS3000 Bachelor's Degree Scheme in Interdisciplinary Studies is not applicable for STARS application.



## A. Completing "Other Experiences and Achievements" Section

1. If you wish to add any competition/activity before submitting your application, please click "+ Add" button beside "Other Experiences and Achievements".



- You are allowed to fill in a maximum of 3 records for this part.
- 2. Select your most outstanding awarded competition/activity (Please select "Other" if you cannot find it from the list provided) and fill in <u>All</u> requested information.



3. Upload the awarding certificate of the competition/activity for verification purpose and click "Yes" if you would like to join Special Talents Admission and Recognition Scheme (STARS) and confirm this award to be considered for STARS application. If no related supporting document provided, your achievement will not be further considered.



3. You are also required to complete two additional questions under the section of STARS Self-description regarding your development of non-academic talent.




- i. For those who have chosen "Sports", "Arts and Culture" or "STEM" as the STARS area, they should also fill in related "Talent".

4. Please enter the corresponding details about the School Principal as your referee and generate the "School Principal Referee Form" for verification purposes. The "Generate School Principal Referee Form" button will be available after you save the sections of STARS self-description and referee content.

5. Please print out the referee from and submit to your high school for signing and stamping. You have to upload the PolyU "School Principal Referee Form for STARS application" with signature and school chop.
