Students admitted to the programme with CBS2151 Chinese III (for NCS students) or equivalent as the entrance requirement should take CBS2154 Chinese IV (for NCS students) as the language compulsory subject.

Students admitted to the programme with CBS2154 Chinese IV (for NCS students) or equivalent as the entrance requirement should take either CBS3152 Spoken Chinese for Business Communication (for NCS students) or CBS3153 Chinese Reading and Writing (for NCS students) as the language compulsory subject.

Students admitted to the programme with CBS3152 Spoken Chinese for Business Communication (for NCS students) or equivalent or CBS3153 Chinese Reading and Writing (for NCS students) or equivalent as the entrance requirement should consult the Programme Leader on which subject should be taken as language compulsory subject.
