

## Selection of Major/Specialism

Starting from the 2022/23 admission exercise, PolyU will adopt a departmental scheme-based admission system, whereby a student can choose his/her own study pathway within a scheme to attain the target graduation award (i.e. a desired major or specialism).

Out of the 31 Schemes on offer, nine Schemes (listed below) have set screening criteria for students to select their major/specialism towards the end of the first year of study. However, applicants with outstanding academic performance will be considered, at the time of admission, for advance placement (with no restrictions to select a desired major/specialism within a Scheme). These applicants will also be notified of this special provision, if applicable, in their Notice of Offer or by separate email in advance of their acceptance.
