BEEE Entry Scholarships for Outstanding HKDSE admittees

To recognize outstanding HKDSE applicants admitted to its full-time undergraduate programme via JUPAS from 2024/25 onwards, the Department of Building Environment and Energy Engineering (BEEE) is establishing a one-off entry scholarship for outstanding HKDSE applicants admitted to the BEng (Hons) Scheme in Building Sciences and Engineering programme.

A one-off entry scholarship with outstanding academic results will be granted to the HKDSE admittee(s). The "Best 5" HKDSE subjects will be considered.

Programme

BEng (Hons) Scheme in Building Sciences and Engineering [JS3110]

Eligibility

All outstanding local HKDSE applicants admitted to the BEng (Hons) Scheme in Building Sciences and Engineering programme will be considered for the Scholarship.

Requirements and Scholarship Amount

The Department's Entry Scholarship is guaranteed if the admittees obtain the best 5 HKDSE subject scores as below:

Tier	HKDSE Requirements	Scholarship Amount
Tier 1	Attain Level 5** in 1 subject <u>OR</u> Attain an aggregate DSE score of 26 or above for the Best 5 subjects	One-off scholarship at HK\$92,100 - Full tuition + Allowance
Tier 2	Attain an aggregate DSE score of 24 or above for the Best 5 subjects	One-off scholarship at HK\$42,100 - Full tuition
Tier 3	Attain an aggregate DSE score of 23 or above for the Best 5 subjects	One-off scholarship at HK\$10,000 - Allowance

Application for the Entry Scholarship

There is no need for students to apply separately for the Entry Scholarship. The Department will identify outstanding applicants and inform awardee(s) after the commencement of the academic year.

Remarks:

- 1 Local students/ JUPAS applicants/ HKDSE admittees refer to those who do not require a student visa to study in Hong Kong.*
- 2 The Extended Mathematics modules will also be considered for scholarship consideration.*
- 3 To calculate the admission scores, HKDSE level attainments will be converted to level points where Level 5**=8.5, 5*=7, 5=5.5, 4=4, 3=3, 2=2, 1=1, and Unclassified=0.*

- 4 A student can concurrently hold more than one scholarship administered by the University in an academic year if the total value of scholarships received by him/her does not exceed his/her annual tuition fee payable plus HK\$50,000 unless otherwise stipulated.*
- 5 Admittees must achieve Level 3 in English Language and Chinese Language and Level 2 in Mathematics, Liberal Studies and Level 3 in two elective subjects to meet the general entrance requirement of PolyU.*
