Background

Introduction

Established in the 1930s, the Department of Building and Real Estate (BRE) has developed a leading position in providing a wide range of academic programmes that nurture preferred graduates for the building and real estate industry in the region. The First Outstanding BRE Alumni Award aims to give public recognition to outstanding graduates of our Department for their distinguished accomplishments in their professions and significant contributions to the community.

Nominations

Nominations for this Award were invited from January to end of April 2010. The nominated candidate must be a bona fide graduate who has successfully completed regular full-time or part-time progammes offered by BRE (forerunners: "Building Department", "Department of Building, Surveying and Structural Engineering" and "Department of Building and Surveying") which lead to academic awards offered by the Department.

Selection Criteria

The major selection criteria include the nominee's:

- 1. Personal achievements / accomplishments in his / her profession
- 2. Contribution to the community in which he / she lives &
- 3. Support to PolyU / BRE and the alumni development

Selection Procedures

Preliminary screening was conducted by the Selection Organizing Committee. The Panel of Judges examined all nominations and had a final assessment of the nominees' qualifications and performance in May 2010.



Mr. NG Wing Hong, one of the first graduates of PolyU's oldest predecessor, the Government Trade School, has been giving unwavering support to his alma mater over the past 70 years. Mr. Ng's connection with PolyU dates back to the turbulent years before the outbreak of World War II. When he started out in the construction industry at the tender age of 15, the daunting experience taught him the importance of a professional education. Therefore, he began his construction studies by enrolling in the Department

of Building of the then Government Trade School in 1937. After finishing his studies in 1939, Mr. Ng devoted the next 50 years to developing his business in construction. He carved out a distinguished professional career and gained wide experience through involvement in a variety of construction projects before his retirement.

A keen supporter of the industry, Mr. Ng served as President of the Hong Kong Building Contractors Association, President of the Students' Society of Hong Kong Technical College and Vice Chairman of Po Leung Kuk in the past. Also, Mr. Ng shared his professional knowledge by teaching evening courses in building subjects at the Trade School.

Currently, Mr. Ng's continued support to the Department and PolyU has set an excellent model for the younger generations. He is now the Honorary Life Chairman of PolyU Development Foundation. As a tribute to Mr. Ng's commitment to the University, PolyU conferred on him the title of University Fellow


