Introduction

Ir. Prof. Johny FAN Siu Kay Higher Diploma in Structural Engineering (Year of Award : 1972) Hong Kong Technical College

Proposer : Ir. Prof. James LAU Chi Wang Higher Diploma in Structural Engineering (1968) Hong Kong Technical College



Ir. Prof. Johnny Fan Siu-kay graduated from the Hong Kong Technical College, with a Higher Diploma from the Department of Building, Surveying and Structural Engineering in 1972. He completed his BSc in Civil Engineering and MSc in Structural Engineering at City University in London. Ir. Fan is currently the Director of WMKY Architects Engineers Ltd and is a leading expert in Hong Kong in precast façade engineering.

With over 40 years of experience in the construction industry, Ir. Fan has introduced a number of new technologies to the Hong Kong construction market including the Daido concrete piling system from Japan and YTONG blocks and panels from Germany. He launched the first precast concrete façade factory in Hong Kong and set up the first steel pipe factory in Hong Kong, fabricating large diameter spiral welded steel pipes for water supply such as the Lo Wu to Shang Shui pipe for the East Pearl River.



Over the years, Ir. Fan has been passing on his valuable experience to the industry through his service to many professional associations and the Hong Kong community.He has been a member of the Rotary Club in Hong Kong (a charitable organization), since 1988 and was President of Rotary Club North West between 1993 and 1994. Ir. Fan also acts as Senior Assistant Commissioner for the



Road Safety Patrol and served as Regional Commander in the East Kowloon District from 1995 to 2005. From 2001 to 2002, he was the Chairman of the Joint Structural Division of The Hong Kong Institution of Engineers.

Ir. Fan has also been devotedly contributing his professional knowledge to the development of his alma mater. Since the 80s, he has been a key member of the PolyU Building Association providing a valuable platform between alumni and students in the construction industry. He was the President of the PolyU Building Association in 1991-1993 and in 1995, was the founding President of the PolyU Civil and Structural Engineering Alumni Association.

Ir. Fan was one of the 13 founding members for the Federation of The PolyU Alumni Association Ltd. He was nominated in 2007 by the Federation to serve as member of the PolyU Council representing the interests of the alumni community. In 2009, Ir. Fan was conferred Fellow of the Polytechnic University. Ir. Fan is now President of the PolyU Federation of Alumni Association and continues to serve on the PolyU Council. In 2012 Ir. Fan was appointed as Adjunct Professor in the Department of Civil and Structural Engineering at PolyU.





Ir. Prof. Peter MOK Kwok Woo *Higher Diploma in Structural Engineering (Year of Award : 1968) Hong Kong Technical College*

Proposer : Mr. LAI Sze Hoi Higher Diploma in Electrical Engineering (1967) Hong Kong Technical College

A structural engineering graduate of the Hong Kong Technical College (now The Hong Kong Polytechnic University) in 1968, Ir. Prof. Peter Mok Kwok Woo was awarded a scholarship to study and work in the United Kingdom, becoming a chartered structural engineer in 1972 and a member of the British team that designed Tsing Yi Bridge, Hong Kong's first cross-channel bridge. After returning to Hong Kong, he worked for the Architectural Office (now the Architectural



Services Department) and at the same time taught in the evening at the Hong Kong Baptist College for five years before setting up his own engineering consultancy firm. In 1981, he founded his own construction company, Sintec Construction Limited, which worked on many government building projects, including Revenue Tower in Wan Chai, the Harbour Building in Central, various Housing Authority public housing projects, schools, a power station and the Whitehead Refugee Centre.



In 1997, Prof. Mok was the co-founder of the Hong Kong Institute of Construction Managers and inaugurated a Quality Charter - the first of its kind amongst professional institutions. Furthermore, from 1998 to 2007, Prof Mok served as the Chairman of the Building and Civil Engineering Training Board of the Vocational Training Council; he was also a member of the Construction Industry Training Authority and Occupational Safety and Health Council for many years, promoting skills assessment schemes for construction workers to ensure higher safety and quality standards. He is now an Adjunct Professor in the Department of Building and Real Estate of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. He was inducted into the HKIE Hall of Fame 2010 by The Hong Kong Institution of Engineers.



Prof. Mok has worked as a volunteer for the Hong Kong Quality Assurance Agency over 20 years and been its chairman since 2007. The Agency plays an important role in promoting quality management system certification, corporate social responsibility, sustainable development and environmental awareness to Hong Kong and mainland companies. In many ways, Prof Mok is a champion of good quality – his work now extends beyond the construction industry to cover a much wider spectrum benefiting the entire community.
