Mr. Alex LUI Chun Wan Higher Certificate in Building (Year of Award: 1964) Hong Kong Technical College

Mr. Alex Lui Chun Wan grew up in Hong Kong. He was a graduate of the Hong Kong Technical College in 1964, awarded with a Higher Certificate in Building with Distinction and later on, he has become an architect and city planner. He studied Architecture at the University of Hong Kong and City Planning at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Other than working in the United States for 12 years, he has spent most of his professional life in Hong Kong, engaging in private practice and gaining extensive professional experience in planning, building and development projects of all kinds. In 1998, he retired from private practice to become a Professor at the Chinese University of Hong Kong, teaching architecture, city planning and urban design and to research into a variety of areas ranging from housing to vernacular architecture, and from professional practice to community development and urban design.

On retirement from teaching in 2002, he was invited to join Hysan Development Company Limited as a Senior Advisor until his retirement in 2008. He was responsible to prepare a strategic plan for the redevelopment of the company's real estate portfolio and was involved in the redevelopment of Hysan Place in Causeway Bay. Among the many projects he has engaged in, the more notable ones include the campus of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, the award-winning Hong Kong Innovation Center and the Jockey Club Environmental Technology Center, Belcher Garden Redevelopment, Healthy Village Redevelopment, K. Wah Center, Ma Wan Island Comprehensive Development, Land Development Corporation's (LDC) Centre Street Redevelopment Study, Wanchai Market Redevelopment, and several major projects in China such as Henderson Center in Beijing and the China Merchants Bank Building in Shanghai.

Other than engaging in the education and professional practice, Alex has been very active in participating in professional institutions in advancing architecture, planning and urban design in Hong Kong. He is a member of the Hong Kong Institute of Planners and a member of the Hong Kong Institute of Architects, in which he has also served as Chairman of the Lands and Planning Committee, a member of the Board of Local Affairs and a member of the Board of Education Affairs. He was Honorary Treasurer for two terms in the Hong Kong Chapter of the American Institute of Architects. He has also helped to set up and served in the Hong Kong Urban Design Alliance.

For many years, Alex has been involved in public and community services in Hong Kong. He has served several terms as a member of Appeal Tribunal Panel of the Building Ordinance (Cap. 123); a member of the Advisory Committee on Appearances of Bridges and Associated Structures; a member of the Appeal Board under the Construction Workers Registration Ordinance (Cap. 583); a member of the Executive Committee and a member of the Supervisory Board of the Hong Kong Housing Society. Before that, he was appointed as a member of the Tax Appeal Board; a member of the Authorized Persons and Registered Structural Engineers Registration Committee; a member of the Town Planning Board; a member of Construction Advisory Board; and a Small Works Committee Member of the Wanchai District Council. Since 2010, he has served as a member of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Council for 2 terms and has joined The Hong Kong Polytechnic University Fellow' by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

Sr Augustine Wong Ho Ming, JP, as the Executive Director and General Manager, is overseeing the property development opportunities and managing the land holdings of Henderson Land Development Co. Ltd., a prominent player in the property development field and a blue chip listed company in Hong Kong. He specializes in the acquisition of aged properties in the urban areas for redevelopment purpose as well as acquisition of agriculture land in the New Territories for conversion to development sites. Henderson has the largest land holdings in urban redevelopment sites and agricultural land in Hong Kong.

He has been well equipped with the extensive and in-depth knowledge gained previously in a leading surveying consultancy firm on land administration, town planning, valuation and marketing after graduating from the then Hong Kong Polytechnic with the Advanced Higher Diploma in General Practice Surveying in 1983. Effective communication ability with different stakeholders in both public and private sectors is also very important for his job. He is the Fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors and served previously as Council member of the General Practice Division and the Board of Membership. He also holds a Master Degree of Science in E-Commerce for Executives by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University and a Master Degree of Economics by the University of Hong Kong.

Augustine also actively serves the community and the alma mater as members of various advisory boards. He is currently the Member of the Radio Television Hong Kong (RTHK) Board of Advisor, the Statistics Advisory Board, and the Appeal Board on Public Meetings and Procession; the Chairman of the Real

Estate Services Training Board of the Vocational Training Council and the Convener of the Legal Sub-Committee of the Real Estate Developers Association of Hong Kong. He was the Member of the Housing Authority, the Estate Agents Authority, the Long Term Housing Strategy Steering Committee, the Land and Building Advisory Committee, the Commission on Strategic Development Committee on Economic Development and Economic Cooperation with the Mainland, the Estate Agents Appeal Board and the Part-Time Member of the Central Policy Unit of the Government of the HKSAR. For the alma mater, he served as the Member of the Departmental Advisory Committee and the External Examiner of the Building and Real Estate Department. He was appointed as Justice of Peace in 2008. He has also been contributing in various ways to the housing issues of the people in need.

He passionately participates in the Scout activities despite the busy schedule. He is the Chairman of the Estate Committee and the Co-opted Member of the Scout Council as well as the Member of the Executive Committee. He recognizes the importance and diversity of lifelong learning.
