Objectives	Students with 78 hours of Korean language instruction or those with a compatible level of Korean proficiency will acquire communication skills in Korean through media materials, such as Korean K-Pop songs, dramas, TV commercials, internet media, and/or movie clips. Students will be able not only to improve their Korean proficiency through authentic language inputs from diverse contexts, but also to learn the communication norms in Korean with greater exposure to Korean culture taking advantage of technology tools including GenAI.
Intended Learning Outcomes	 Upon completion of the subject, students will be able to: a. achieve an intermediate level of proficiency in speaking, listening, reading, and writing; b. acquire communication norms in Korean and socio-cultural awareness of the Korean society through media. c. have confidence in communicating with others as a social being; and d. develop lifelong language learning skills, including learning and practicing languages using GenAI tools.

Teaching/Learning Methodology

Every week students learn new words, grammar points, expressions, and communicative and cultural norms through short clips (around 5 minutes for each clip) of multimedia materials (K-Pop songs, television dramas, commercials or films) or authentic resources on the internet. The mode of teaching and learning is highly interactive, and students practice through role-plays or skits, some of which will be tested as a quiz. Additionally, through the use of GenAI tools, students can enhance their understanding of Korean language and cultural nuances, enriching their overall learning experience.

Students' improvement is assessed in a range of different tasks, both oral and written ones.
