Dr. Anthony P.H. Kong is currently the Unit Head of the Academic Unit of Human Communication, Development, and Information Sciences (CDIS) and Director of Aphasia Research and Therapy (ART) Laboratory at The University of Hong Kong (HKU). He is a Fellow of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association and Academy of Aphasia. Dr. Kong's research interests include stroke-induced aphasia, discourse analyses, and neurogenic communication disorders in multilingual speakers. Over the years, he has developed several clinically-oriented language and cognitive assessment tools/batteries geared for Chinese speakers, including the MCA, CLCM, HK-OCS, HK-BCoS, and Cant-CAT. He is also the Editor-in-Chief of Cogent Gerontology (Taylor & Francis).



Mr. Chester Cheung is a PhD student at HKU, who is working on a project related to EEG-guided individualized tACS intervention for Chinese aphasia.

Ms. Cherie Wong is a PhD student at HKU, who is working on a project related to Intensive Comprehensive Aphasia Program (ICAP) in Chinese.

Workshop Description

MCA is a clinical assessment battery for evaluating discourse performance in speakers with acquired language disorders, such as aphasia. The tool uses a sequential picture description task to elicit language samples, which are then utilized as the basis of discourse analysis. The MCA has been standardized in native English, Cantonese, Mandarin, Japanese, Spanish, and Dutch. Language sample collection and index calculation can be completed in 20 minutes for most examinees.


