He is the lead author of HKGCNT published in 2008.

Workshop Description

HKGCNT is designed for use by professionals serving children with reading difficulties. It is a simple assessment tool through which a primary school child's reading ability can be compared with children of the same grade. Test results also provide specific information for therapeutic management. The test kit comprises a test manual, six different stimulus presentation sheets and six different recording forms for each of the different grades.

This three-hour certification workshop will cover:

- 1. Theory of Chinese character reading
- 2. Test development and standardisation
- 3. Test features and application
- 4. Implications for therapeutic management of reading difficulties
