

AI Tools for Cantonese Language Learning on Online Platforms

1. Cantonese.ai

This platform offers a suite of Cantonese learning functions: AI-enabled pronunciation practice with automated feedback and scoring, Jyutping text conversion, Cantonese text-to-speech, Cantonese speech-to-text transcription, a natural Cantonese AI chatbot for reading, writing and conversational practice, and lip-synced talking and video avatars to enhance engagement in listening and speaking exercises.

- **AI-powered Cantonese pronunciation practice:** Learners can practise Cantonese pronunciation and receive AI-powered feedback and scoring.
 - **Jyutping conversion:** The platform can convert Chinese text into Jyutping, helping learners understand Cantonese pronunciation and romanisation.
 - **Text-to-speech support:** Learners can convert text into natural Cantonese speech and listen to model pronunciation.
 - **Speech-to-text transcription:** Cantonese audio can be transcribed into text, helping learners check what they hear or say.

Learners can practise vocabulary and grammar in context, follow a beginner-friendly path, and choose Yale, Jyutping, or Chinese characters. It also supports learners without character knowledge and offers helpful blog resources.

- **AI-powered conversations:** CantonLink allows learners to practise **real-time conversations with AI tutors**. Learners can explore new words, practise vocabulary and grammar, and simulate conversations with real people.
 - **Structured lessons and assessments:** The platform provides organised units, lessons, and assessments. Learners can study greetings, self-introductions, and everyday conversations step by step.

Learners can request Jyutping for pronunciation, compare Cantonese grammar with Mandarin or English, and create role-play dialogues, scripts, and listening exercises to prepare for real-life communication in topics such as food, travel, and daily life.
