Approved arrangement on the size and composition of the Departmental Staffing Committee (DSC)

BRE was invited to review the size and composition of the Departmental Staffing Committee as per emails from the DP and the Dean on 31 May 2019.

With a view to further enhancing a greater operational efficiency while maintaining balanced inputs across the four disciplines in BRE, it is approved that the size of the DSC be reduced from 9 to 5 (inclusive of the Head of Department as the Chairman) :

Chairman : Head of Department

Appointed Members : The most senior staff members (by rank of appointment) from two disciplines (1 for each discipline)

Elected Members : Elected members from the other two disciplines not serving as appointed members (1 for each discipline)
