

Presentation title: HKSTP, InnoCell – 1st Hybrid MiC Pilot Project in Hong Kong

Abstract:

HKSTP, InnoCell is the first high rise hybrid MiC building in Hong Kong, it is a 17-storey tower with common area for co-working and co-living spaces, where 15-storey is constructed by 418 nos. modules in Modular Integrated Construction (MiC) method.

The project has also showcased usage of other smart technologies, such as DfMA, BIM, VR and AR Technology, 3D Scanning & Printing, Smart Helmet, QR Code E-inspection System, etc.
