

CRRT Notice (265): Updates on Campus Access and Daily Reporting of COVID-19 Cases

Dear Colleagues and Students

The Government has announced scrapping LeaveHomeSafe scanning when entering venues and amber health code for incoming travellers with effect from 14 December 2022. In this connection, the University will adopt the same measures for campus access accordingly.

Campus visitors and contractors should continue to follow the existing registration protocol set by the Campus Facilities and Sustainability Office, despite that they are NOT required to use the “LeaveHomeSafe” mobile app to scan QR codes. Venue QR codes on campus will be removed momentarily.

Please note that the vaccine pass requirements still apply to some scheduled premises, such as restaurants, where patrons must show venue staff their COVID-19 vaccination records.

The Taskforce will continue uploading the daily CRRT notice of reported cases to the PolyU intranet but suspend disseminating the same notice copy to all staff and student email accounts. Related information is accessible via the COVID-19 InfoHub
