

## Vaccine Pass Arrangements

The Vaccine Pass has entered the second stage from 30 April 2022, except under exempted scenarios (e.g. for those issued with a COVID-19 Vaccination Medical Exemption Certificate, recovery record or for other specified scenarios), and includes the following requirements:

- (a) persons aged 18 or above are required to receive at least two doses of COVID-19 vaccine to continue to use the Vaccine Pass;
- (b) if persons aged 12 to 17 have received their first dose of COVID-19 vaccine for less than six months, their Vaccine Pass remains valid; however, if they have received their first dose for more than six months, they will need to receive a second dose to continue to use the Vaccine Pass.

Please also note that at the third stage of Vaccine Pass (i.e. from 31 May 2022 onwards), there is a grace period of six months for persons aged 12 or above (not recovered persons) to receive the third dose after the second dose. In other words, for those who receive their second dose within six months, their Vaccine Pass is still valid. This grace period is also applicable to PolyU staff and students for campus access.
