

Notice on Response Actions for the Novel Coronavirus (31): Updated Social Distancing and Precautionary Measures on Campus and in Hostels

Dear Staff and Students,

In light of the improved situation with COVID-19 in Hong Kong, the Government has announced the relaxation of some of the social distancing measures in relation to catering business, scheduled premises and group gathering in public places for the period 8 May to 21 May 2020.

In this connection, the Senior Management has decided that, with effect from 8 May 2020, some of the social distancing measures implemented on the campus and in the hostels will be relaxed until further notice. The revised measures are as follows:

- 1. All forms of non-essential face-to-face interactions among students and/or staff on campus and in the hostels involving more than eight persons are not allowed.
- 2. The seating in the canteens and at other catering outlets will be re-arranged to comply with the latest social distancing requirements announced by the Government. No more than eight persons may be seated together at one table.

Other social distancing and enhanced precautionary measures as announced in Notices No. 24 and No. 25 shall continue to be in force until further notice.
