Dear Colleagues and Students

The Task Force supports the Government's latest appeal to the public to get vaccinated so that the city can gradually return to normality and get through the pandemic as soon as possible.

As you may know, the Government has launched a territory-wide COVID-19 Vaccination Programme (the Programme) which is free of charge for all Hong Kong residents. This is one of the means to safeguard public health and to allow the resuming of normal activities of society gradually.
