

Response Actions for the Novel Coronavirus: Returning Hall Residents

Dear Students,

As you have been informed by the University, any PolyU student or staff member who has traveled to Mainland China in the past 14 days is now required to undertake self-quarantine for 14 days upon his or her return to Hong Kong. During this tough period, the top priority of the University and the whole society is to take all necessary precautionary measures to minimize the health risks of the novel coronavirus. Given the limited capacity of our Student Halls to accommodate and support hall residents undertaking self-quarantine and in the best interest of the health of all students, please be informed that we will no longer admit returning hall residents requiring quarantine rooms back to the halls with immediate effect except for students who are already on the way. We are sorry for the inconvenience that this policy will cause to some of you, but we seek your understanding and cooperation in implementing this policy.

Since no face-to-face teaching will take place before 29 March, we strongly urge you to continue to stay where you are for online learning activities.
