Abstract

Pursuing a PhD in cybersecurity involves navigating a range of challenges and opportunities, particularly in building a strong publication record and scholarly profile. In this talk, I will share some tips for cybersecurity-focused PhD students on how to strategically select research topics, identify appropriate publication venues, and effectively communicate research findings within the academic community. Attendees will gain insights into good practices for establishing a solid publication track record and developing a scholarly profile that supports long-term career growth in cybersecurity research. This session aims to provide actionable advice to help PhD students enhance their publication success and professional development throughout their doctoral studies.

About the Speaker

Prof. Joseph Liu is a Full Professor in the Faculty of Information Technology, Monash University in Melbourne, Australia. He got his PhD from the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 2004. His research areas include cybersecurity, blockchain and applied cryptography. He has received more than 16000 citations and his H-index is 72, with more than 200 publications in top venues such as CRYPTO, ACM CCS, IEEE S&P, NDSS. He has received more than US\$10M funding, and he is currently the Director of the Monash Blockchain Technology Centre. He has been given the prestigious ICT Researcher of the Year 2018 Award by the Australian Computer Society (ACS), and has won the IEEE Technical Achievement Award in 2021 given by the Technology and Engineering Management Society for his achievement in the blockchain and cybersecurity domain. He has several patents and international standards from his research contributions to be adopted by the industry.
