

At the University's 18th Congregation held on 27 October, PolyU sent 十月二十七日,理大舉行第十八屆畢業禮,頒 forth about 10,720 graduates, including 171 Doctor of Philosophy, 27 discipline-based Doctor's degree, 80 Master of Philosophy, 3,918 位哲學博士、27位專業範疇的修課式博士、80 Master's degree, 4,969 Bachelor's degree, 63 postgraduate diploma and certificate, and 1,491 sub-degree awards. Presiding over the occasion were Council Chairman Ms Marjorie Yang and President Prof. Timothy W. Tong.

PolyU's School of Hotel and Tourism Managemen (SHTM) has received the McCool Breakthrough Award from the International Council of Hotel Restaurant, and Institutional Education (I-CHRIE). The award recognizes the SHTM's breakthrough in the form of its teaching and research hotel. Hotel ICON, the heart of its innovative approach to hospitality and tourism education.

I-CHRIE, the world's largest organization of hospitality and tourism educators, presents the annual McCool Breakthrough Award in memory of the successful astronaut Willie McCool

In 2009, the SHTM was ranked second internationally amongst hotel and tourism schools based on research and scholarship. Wholly owned by PolyU and an extension of the SHTM, Hotel ICON is the world's first purpose-built teaching and research hotel that fully integrates teaching, learning and research in a full service environment.
