Pottery can be shaped by a range of methods; the most common ways are hand-building and wheel throwing. You can try out both methods, mould the shape with tools, make the accessories and know how to decorate your works with glaze in this workshop, which will provide you a full experience of pottery making. The tutor will also show you some ceramic works and share with you how they can be appreciated.

Ms Aidan Wong is a local ceramic artist who has over 30 years' experience in ceramic art. Her work Fountain was selected for the 14th Hong Kong Art Biennial Exhibition and is now part of the permanent collection at the Hona Kona Museum of Art.
