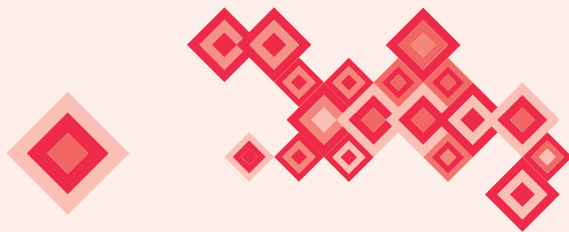

PolyU's Artist-in-Residence 2011/12, Prof. Norman W.M. Ko hosted his first sculpture workshop during his residency. In this year's Art Pal he will host another workshop and share with you his experience in sculpting. Come along and learn about sculpting from Prof. Ko and create your own sculpture model from polyfoam in this workshop.

Prof. Ko began creating sculpture in 1979. He won the Urban Council Fine Arts Award for Sculpture in 1983 and is a founder member and former President of the Hong Kong Sculptors Association. Many of his larger sculptures are on display in public places in Hong Kong and he presented his first open-air exhibition at the 4th PolyU Arts Festival in 2009. Private collectors around the world collect his smaller works. Prof. Ko is also a well-known photographer; his photographs have been exhibited on PolyU campus.

In 2011, Prof. Ko donated his sculpture *Soaring* to PolyU, while in 2012 he donated a set of sculptures, jointly named *Vision*.

高華文教授是2011/12年度香港理工大學駐校藝術家。高教授當年不僅展出他的攝影及雕塑精品，更首次主持一個為期多天的雕塑班。是次ART PAL，理大有幸邀得高教授再度主持另一雕塑班，分享他的創作方法和心得。高教授在是次雕塑班中，將會指導學員製作他們自己設計的雕塑初型。

高華文教授自1979年起從事雕塑藝術，1983年便贏得香港市政局雕塑藝術獎，曾先後擔任香港雕塑家協會創會會員及主席。高教授的作品是世界各地收藏家的珍藏。高教授許多大型雕塑作品置放於香港多處公共地方。他曾於理大第四屆藝術節中舉行第一個個人戶外雕塑展覽。高教授除了是著名的雕塑藝術家外，也是享有盛名的攝影師，曾先後在理大校園展出其雕塑和攝影作品。

高教授積極推動本港雕塑藝術，亦非常支持理大推廣文化，分別於2011年及2012年捐贈其心血作品「翱翔」和「遠瞻」予理大，置放於校園中。
