Tang Chung Ling Ancestral Hall Lung Yeuk Tau, Fanling Lung Yeuk Tau is located northeast of Luen Wo Hui, Fanling in the New Territories. It is the home of the Tang Clan who were the descendants of the Song Dynasty. As the clan prospered, it branched out to the neighbouring area and established the present-day "Five Wais and Six Tsuens" within a few hundred years. Many traditional Chinese buildings and structures have been preserved in their original state, thus demonstrating the history and life of the early inhabitants in the New Territories.
