You can try out both methods, mould the shape with tools, make the accessories and know how to decorate your works with glaze in this workshop, which will provide you with a full experience of pottery making. The tutor will also show you some ceramic works and share with you how they can be appreciated.

Ms Aidan Wong is a local ceramic artist who has over 30 years' experience in ceramic art. Her work *Fountain* was selected for the 14<sup>th</sup> Hong Kong Art Biennial Exhibition and is now part of the permanent collection at the Hong Kong Museum of Art.
