The regular script (kaishu) came into being between the Eastern Han dynasty and Three Kingdoms period. It is square in style with distinctive strokes. The regular script is still a very common style and a must-learn style for beginners who practice calligraphy. The workshop will provide participants with a general grounding in regular script. Mr Lau Hok-ching will demonstrate and teach the participants to write in regular script.

Mr Lau Hok-ching is an experienced Chinese calligraphy teacher. In the last two decades, Mr Lau has hosted more than 10 exhibitions displaying both his own work and that of his students.
