

# Exploring CILL AI Tools - Yoodli

## Objectives

- Use Yoodli to simulate job interviews, presentations, and difficult conversations.
- Receive analytics on delivery metrics such as pacing, filler words (e.g., "um", "ah"), and body language.
- Critically review AI feedback to refine communication style and confidence.

## Location

- SAP Rooms (Speaking Assistance Programme Room) and MoCoWs in CILL (Room A305).

## Instructions for Use:

### 1) Access the tool

- Turn on the dedicated computer / MoCoW in CILL (A305).
- Open the **Yoodli** shortcut on the desktop.

### 2) Login

- Click "**Sign in with email**".
- **Important:** You will see login details (email/password) already pre-filled on the screen. **Do NOT modify or change these details.**
- Simply click "**sign-in**" button to proceed.

### 3) Select a Practice Mode

- Once logged in, select a practice mode that fits your goals:
  - Presentation:** Upload slides or speak impromptu to practise a speech.
  - Interview:** Answer simulated interview questions generated by the AI.
  - Roleplay:** Explore the "Roleplay" function to practise specific scenarios (e.g., salary negotiation, difficult colleagues).

### 4) Review Feedback

- After your recording, review the dashboard for insights on your eye contact, pacing, and word choice.

### 5) Finishing Up - Privacy & Security (Crucial)

- **Before you leave:** You must **delete your practice recordings**.
- Go to "My Yoodlis" or the Dashboard.
- Click the three dots (...) next to your video and select **Delete**.
- This protects your privacy and ensures your recordings are not viewed by the next student using the shared account.

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
