Subject Synopsis/ Indicative Syllabus	This subject is part of the University's outcome-based programme for research students. Unlike conventional, classroom-based subjects, it does not have an indicative syllabus. All PhD students, irrespective of funding source and mode of study, are required to complete 2 training credits before graduation. To earn 1 credit, students are required to engage in teaching/- professional service assigned by the HoD or his/her delegate for 6 hours/week in any 13-week semester. Students can complete these 2 credits any time before they graduate. They can choose to complete these 2 credits in two different semesters or within the same semester, subject to the approval of the Chief Supervisor.
